

APPLICATION FOR ADOPT THE PUBLIC WAY GRANTS — 2017

The Rogers Park Garden Group (RPGG) is pleased to be able to offer a limited number of **GRANTS BETWEEN \$100 AND \$500** for the improvement of spaces relating to our neighborhood's public way.

Grants are also available for agencies or organizations that work with children and youth (a separate application form is available on the RPGG website).

Application Components

Application must include all of the following completed forms:

- Project Description
- Intent Statement including proof or other indication that the applicant(s) have the right to garden at the proposed site
- Budget

Frequently Asked Questions

<i>Who is eligible to apply?</i>	Any individual or group of people
<i>What form does the grant take?</i>	Grant recipients will receive gift certificates to Gethsemane Gardens in Andersonville to purchase plants, soil and/or soil amendments and mulch. Grant amounts will be between \$100 and \$500 depending on the size and needs of the garden and how well it fits the guidelines.
<i>What is expected of me?</i>	Applicants must agree to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Allow the garden to be featured on the RPGG website, and • Communicate with the RPGG on the status of the project.
<i>What do I need to do to apply?</i>	Send the address noted below NO LATER THAN 5pm April 30 for spring grants; or 5pm Sept 15 for fall grants: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The completed Project Description (attached) • The completed Intent Form (attached) • The completed Budget Form (attached)

<p><i>What projects are eligible?</i></p>	<p>Any project that can demonstrate that it:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Improves the public way, • Is located in Rogers Park, specifically: south of Evanston, east of Ridge, north of Devon, • Is capable of completion prior to the expiration date of the grant certificates • Will be undertaken by people with the capacity to complete and maintain it – e.g., weed and water, • Has a realistic budget. <p>Also:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All proposals must be received NO LATER THAN 5:00 pm on the due date to be eligible. <p>NOTE: if you are gardening at a condo association parkway or other public spot, you must have written permission from the condo board.</p>
<p><i>How are projects chosen?</i></p>	<p>The grants are competitive and not every grant request received will be funded. Grant awards may be less than your requested amount. Only applications that meet the guidelines will be considered. Priority will be given to those projects that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create a new garden • Restore and/or enhance an old and/or uncared for garden • Have an achievable plan that is in keeping with the goals of the RPGG Adopt the Public Way Program
<p><i>What is the grant process?</i></p>	<p>All grant requests are due by 5pm April 30 for spring grants; or 5pm Sept 15 for fall grants. After that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An RPGG representative will contact you for a site visit • Grants will be announced within four weeks of the application due date and certificates can be picked up, or will be mailed.
<p><i>Can I apply for the next phases?</i></p>	<p>Your garden can only be awarded a grant once each year. If your application is denied in spring, you may apply again in the fall. You may apply for grants for the same project two years in a row, so if you are awarded a grant in 2016, you may apply again in 2017.</p>
